He married Jean Spradlin September 21, 1946, in Russell, Kentucky, and she died in December of 2010...Cecil was a veteran of World War II and was a retired truck mechanic. His special gift was for music, and he was a member of the Old Time Fiddlers association and played in many contests. As a young musician, he played in bands and entertained at many public functions and on the radio..."
