### **DUSTY MILLER "SEZ"**

Always remember to **pay your accompanists**. The customary fee is 10% of your winnings to each accompanist. For example: If you win \$500 in a fiddle contest, you should give each of your accompanists \$50. Therefore, if you had three accompanists, the fiddle player would make \$350, and the accompanists would make \$150 (\$50 each). Remember, some of the best accompanists in the world are from Texas!
