Howdy members!

As I reported to you last month, Bart Baker, Julie Morris, and I will be stepping down from our board positions this November. I hope that each of you is considering taking up one of those positions. This organization needs each of its members to take an active role, whether in a board position or not, but certainly those who are on the board are able to strongly influence its growth and success. To help you with your decision, so you know what you're getting into, here is my opinion of the duties for each of the positions. These are my perceptions based on my two years of experience.

<u>President</u>: Often is the first contact from persons or organizations outside of TOTFA. The president is responsible for talking to the non-TOTFA / non-fiddler community to generate interest in fiddling, setting the direction of the organization, and seeing that its business is being done. He reaches out to his board and other helpers. He should NOT have to be doing it all. He needs support from his directors who will take on assignments and other tasks.

<u>Director</u>: Reaches out to non-TOTFA organizations and people. Actively participates in board meetings, bringing ideas and provides their thoughts to other board members. Takes on assignments and duties as they come. Represents TOTFA and "runs" one or more fiddle contests: makes contact with the host, finds judges, checks contestants' memberships and registers new members, ensures the results and payouts are captured and that, in general, the contest is run according to TOTFA rules. Reaches out to helpers.

<u>Secretary</u>: Performs director's duties, plus... schedules meetings, takes meeting notes, and prepares meeting minutes. Sees that minutes are published in the Fiddler newsletter. Leads the meeting discussion or ensures that someone else will. Preserves meeting notes and minutes. Gathers and preserves contest results, judges' scoresheets, and other documents from each TOTFA contest.

Treasurer: Performs director's duties, plus... maintains the TOTFA bank account ensuring that all expenses and income are appropriately recorded. Provides income statement at board meetings and for newsletter publication. Ensures that expenses are paid and deposits are made appropriately.

Again, these are my opinions of the responsibilities for each board position. They aren't written in stone. We help each other out; if someone can't do something, then someone else steps in to fill the gap. I encourage you to actively participate in our organization. I'll say again that I'm proud of our progress over the past 2 years. I honestly believe that great things are ahead for TOTFA and I encourage you to accept a board position and be an influential part of it for the next 2 years.
