Convention News

The annual convention of the Texas Old Time Fiddlers Association took place on Sunday, November 13 at the Somervell County Exposition Center in Glen Rose, Texas.

During the proceedings, Bart Baker resigned his post as president and nominated Jordan Bankston to replace him. Motion was seconded and Jordan was elected as president by majority vote.

David Walker was motioned, seconded, and elected by majority to fill the board position vacated by Jordan.

A revision to the by-laws had been proposed by Ed Carnes to exempt fiddlers who are 13 and younger from having to become TOTFA members to compete in a TOTFA contest. After discussion among members in attendance, the revision was passed by majority vote. Article VIII, General Provisions, section G. Registration was revised from: "A contestant must be a member in good standing to register for competition. A contestant must be a member in good standing to register for a contest." to "A contestant must be a member in good standing to register for competition; however, this requirement is waived for fiddlers 13 years of age or younger for one (1) contest per year and for any contest held in their county of residence, as an incentive to become a member. A contestant must be present in order to register for a contest."
