Hello TOTFA membership! The end of summer is approaching and we have a few contests for you over the next couple of months. August is over, but it did not end nicely. We had a total eclipse, and a massive catastrophic hurricane as well. I know that some of our members have been displaced, and have received everything from minor damage like fallen trees, all the way up to severe damages by winds and flooding to their entire homes.

I want everyone to know that our thoughts and prayers have been with you during this terrible time. I also could not be more proud of the fellowship of our sister states, the neighbors all around the state, and the complete strangers that have put differences aside and taken time to come out and help with the relief efforts after Hurricane Harvey. This is an absolute catastrophe, but I know we will continue through and do our best.

On a more positive note, we have a great, long-standing contest next week on September 8<sup>th</sup>. The Johnson County Pioneer & Old Settlers Reunion falls this week and next week. This year makes the 125<sup>th</sup> year that they have held a reunion, and Johnson County is making this a big shindig. I hope all of you can take some time to come up. Alvarado is a small town that I have previously called home, and is conveniently located on I-35W just south of Fort Worth. You can blink your eyes and miss it, but they are pulling out all the stops in this little Texas town.

This is going to be a *full 7 days* of activities. Beginning a week before the contest, on Sept. 2<sup>nd</sup>, they are starting off with a parade, dancing-horse show, (yes dancing horses) and

celebrity goat dressing contest. Saturday night, Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup>, Texas Country artist, Austin Allsup is headlining the show. The next week will consist of mutton busting, gospel music, baby contest, bar-b-que cook-off and bake-off, Johnson County Queen contest. Carnival Rides begin on Wednesday, Sept 6<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.

The Fiddle Contest is on Friday, Sept.8<sup>th</sup> with Registration at 6pm, and contest starting at 7pm. There has been an upgrade to the sound system this year, and it should make for a much better attraction for such a great audience that turns out every year. The reunion will end on Saturday, Sept. 9<sup>th</sup> with an Arts and Craft show and vendors, car show, and chuck wagon demonstration. The finale the celebration is *a free concert* from our very own Texas staple, *Asleep at the Wheel* beginning Saturday, Sept.9<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm-9pm. In September, we have a long-running contest not sanctioned by TOTFA, in Crockett, Texas. The World Championship Fiddlers Festival will be held Sept.23<sup>rd</sup> and they will be honoring the Solomon family and Mr. Bobby Christman this year. On October 7<sup>th</sup>, we have the Bowie Chicken and Bread Days Fiddle Contest in Bowie, Texas. This has been a staple in the TOTFA scene for as long as I can remember. The weather is always great and the community comes out to show their support. There is a car show, antique malls on the square, and many vendors and craft booths. I spoke this week with Mr. Jesse Roy Hart who has always helped us get the Sequin contest going. This fiddle contest will be on October 14<sup>th</sup> and is one of the only ones we have left in the area and it has been running for 36 years!!!! This is a great contest that runs in conjunction with the Guadalupe County Fair, so you can be assured that the kids and family will have plenty to do during the day. We would love to see some support.
